A. Head of Delegation

E. Overseas Preparation for Athletes

In 2023 Iven Moise spent 3 and a half (3.5) months at the J C Eten training Centre in Kenya. Denzel Adem and Caleb Vadivello atteded 6 weeks preparation in South Africa. Sharry Dodin attended training in Europe and Kenya. **Athlete's expenses ???**

G. Financial support from Government

For the final year of preparation, the Seychelles Athletics Federation received around RS 980 000.00 as financial support from the National Sports Council from the Games preparation budget, placing the Federation in the 8th position on the Funds to Federation list from NSC.

H. Incentives for medal winners and PBs

SAF rewarded Iven Moise for the 2 gold medals and for establishing a new national record in the 10 000m, with financial incentives.

I. Overall performance

In terms of gold medals, the athletics team won 2 gold, that was 4 medals less than what was achieved in 2019. It is worth noting that 3 athletes who were medals contenders were not able to defend their gold medals won in 2019. The athletes were Ned Azemia, Silly Gaylord and Natacha Chetty,

Denzel Adem and Dyland Sicobo who were also a strong contender for medals. They did not make the team due to injuries.

J. Recommendations for improvement

Despite some minor challenges, the Seychelles Athletics Federation is of the opinion that the 11th Indian Ocean Island Games was successfully organized. From the performances registered, the experienced gained the necessary platform for improved performances in the coming Games have been laid.

However, this will only happen with advanced planning and preparation, clear direction and targets and necessary support and collaboration from the key partners within and outside the Department of Sports
